LIMITED WARRANTY

CONFORMING TO INDUSTRY STANDARDS

Asian Pacific Products, INC. warrants its products against manufacturing defects for a period of one year from date of shipment to the retailer. It is the responsibility of the customer, contractor, architect, installer, and finisher to follow these requirements and conditions stated below:

Before installation of Asian Pacific Products, INC. Doors:

- 1) Check the building codes and regulations for your area.
- 2) Check door for warping*, glass, moulding, manufacturing defect and freight damage.
- 3) Do not cut, hang, or finish a door without first checking items #1 and #2.

Hanging and Finishing Asian Pacific Products, INC. Doors:

- 4) Door must be fully sealed on all six sides (including behind hinges and hardware) with an approved exterior finish or paint within 24 hours after hanging.
- 5) Stained doors must have at least 3 finish coats (Polyurethane or Varathane).
- 6) All doors must have adequate protection **against direct sunlight, rain, wind, abnormal heat and sudden changes in temperatures.
- 7) In order not to induce warping and cracking, do not expose stained doors or dark colored doors to direct sunlight or southwestern exposure.

Asian Pacific Products, INC. Warranty:

- 8) Asian Pacific Products, INC. will not assume any responsibility or cost for re-hanging and/or refinishing, unless purchased as an Asian Pacific Products, INC. factory pre-hung / pre-finished unit.
- 9) In case of a defective door, it is the option of Asian Pacific Products, INC. to (a) repair the door (b) replace the door or (c) refund the wholesale cost of the door.

ATTENTION: ALL OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS MUST BE MET TO VALIDATE YOUR WARRANTY.

* When warranty requirements and conditions above are met, Asian Pacific Products, INC. will replace the door for warpage exceeding 1/4" on doors up to 80" high.

** Adequate protection from weather is determined by the following: measure from the bottom of the door to where the overhang joins the wall (A). This measurement is then divided by 2 (B). This (B) is minimum distance your overhang must extend from the face of the door for full warranty coverage. Example: A = 90" B must equal 45" or greater for warranty coverage.
